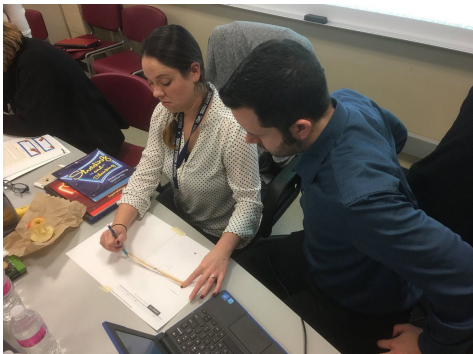
PENNIES FOR PATIENTS

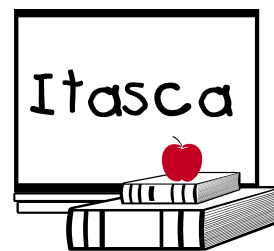

Franzen Talent Show is coming up March! Good luck to all performers!

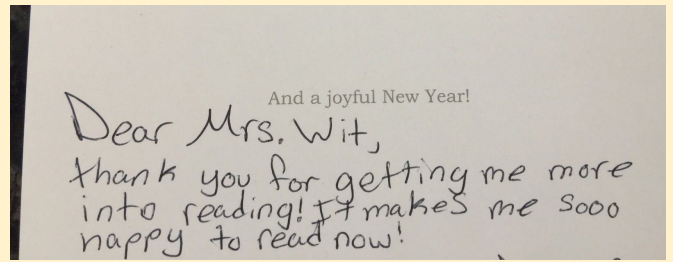
