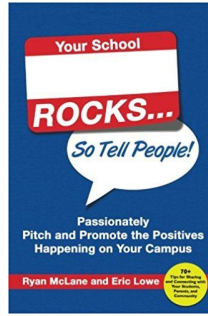
SUMMER LEARNING CAMP
